

## **Pronouns And Their Possessives**

<b>he, him, his</b>	<b>they, them, theirs</b>
<b>she, her, hers</b>	<b>it, its</b>

**Note: "it's" is ALWAYS a contraction of "it is"  
You can remember "its" is the possessive form  
for "it" by remembering "his" and "hers" have  
no apostrophes, and neither does "its"**
