


Dan is a man. Sam is a man. Rat is a cat. Dan, Sam, and Rat The Cat went to the lake in Dan's tan van.

"I hate the lake," said Rat.




At the lake was a tame ape.

"I hate Dave the tame ape," said Rat.




Jane came to the lake. She was not late.


"I can bake a cake," said Dan.

"I hate cake," said Rat.




Sam can bake a cake. Jane can bake a cake. But Dan made the cake at the lake.
