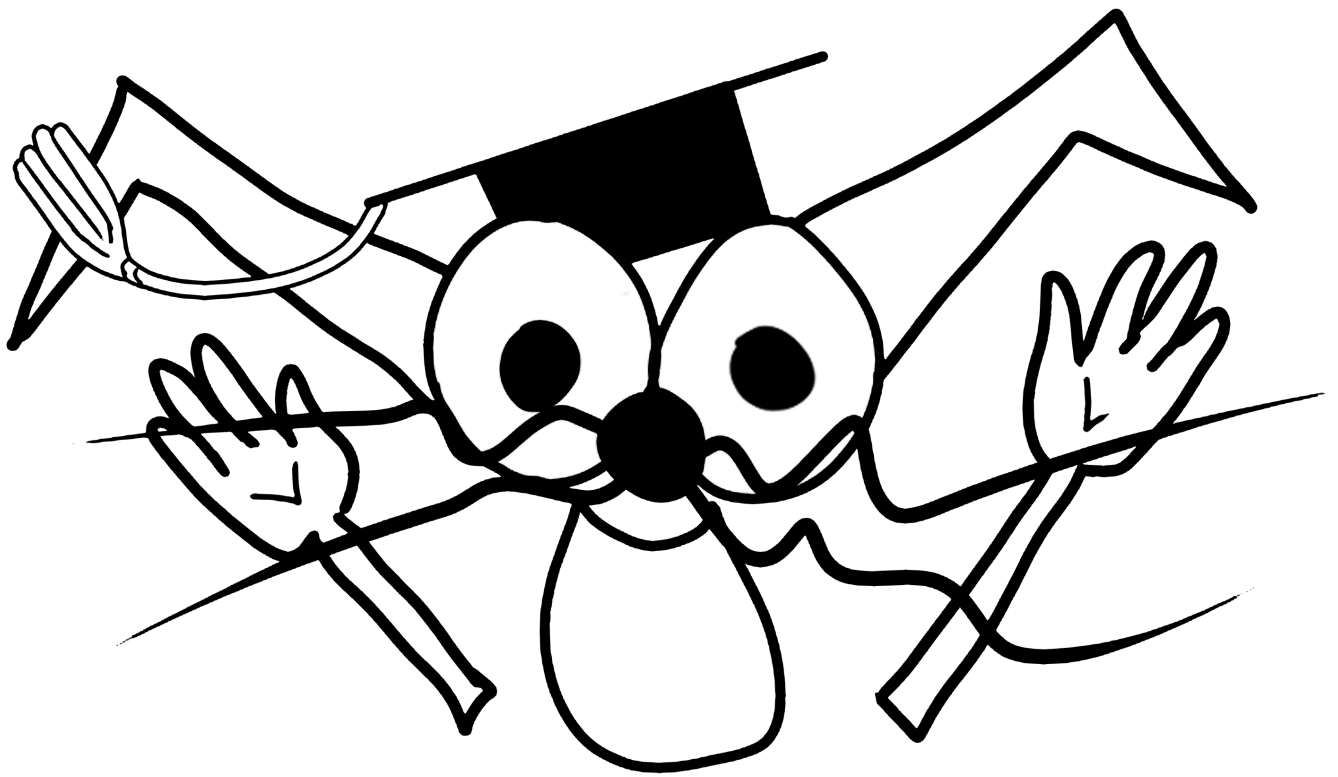


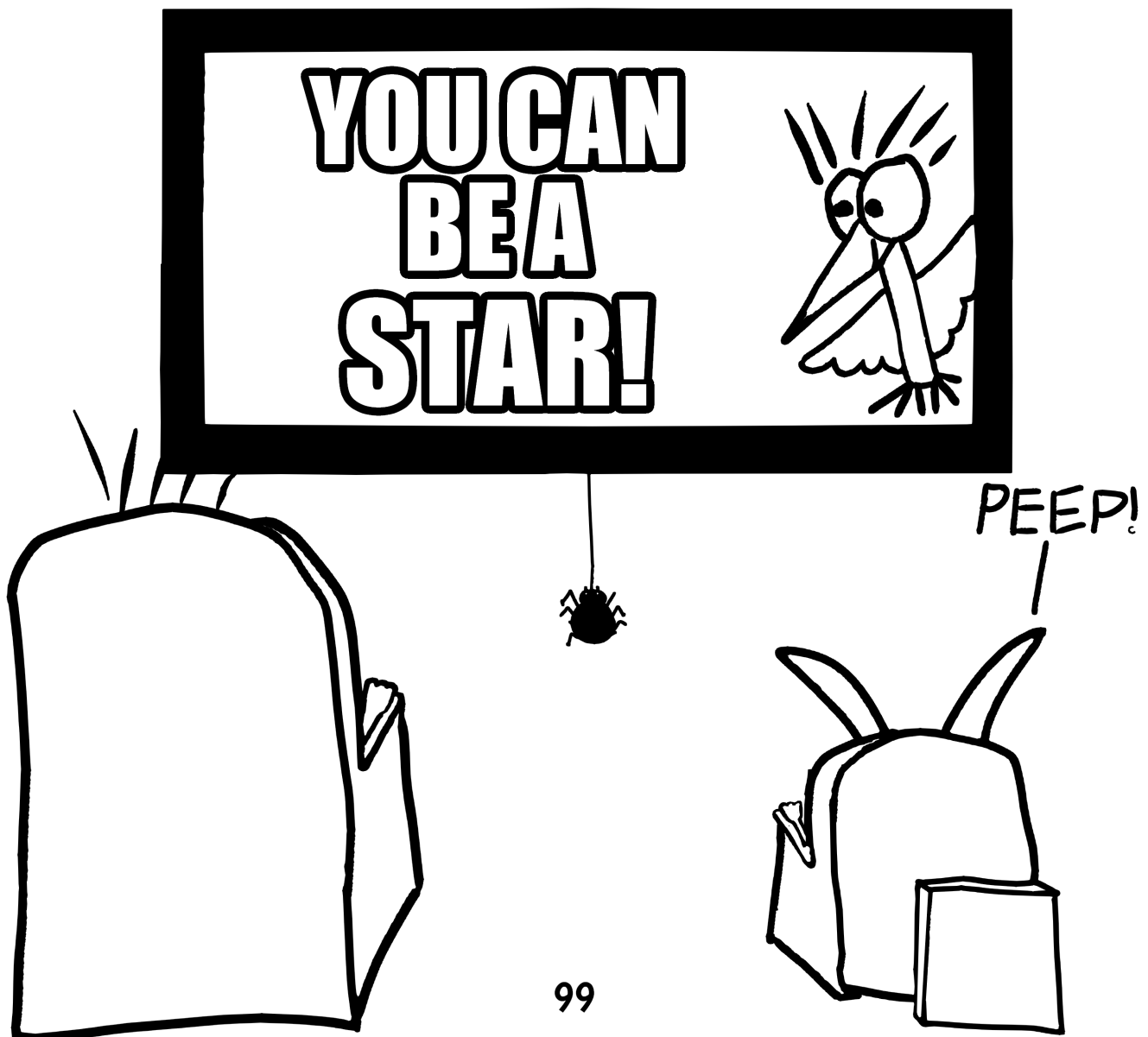

As Dan and Rat sat by the TV, a PEEP came from Rat.



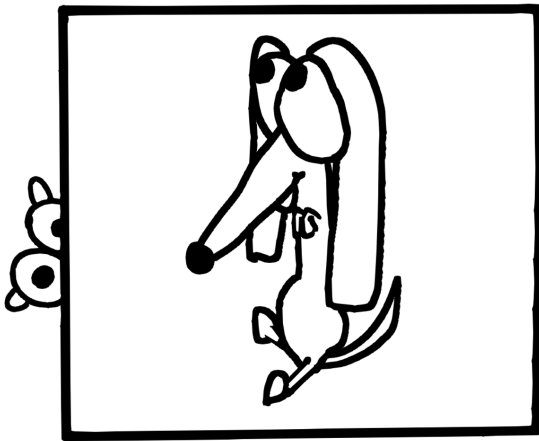
**"Was that a PEEP?" asked Dan.

TV went BEEP."**



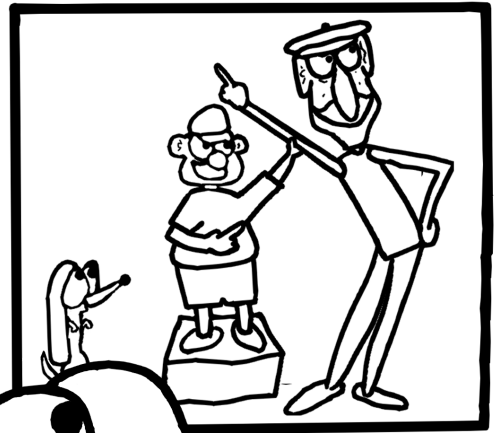
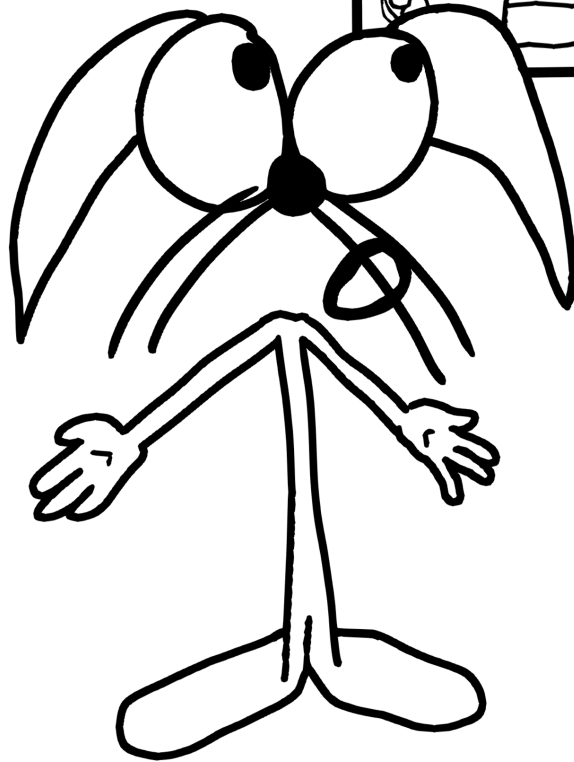
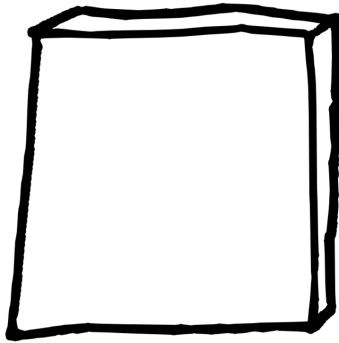
Rat The Cat went PEEP one more time.

"Rat!" said Dan. "Did you take a zoo animal to keep as a pet?"

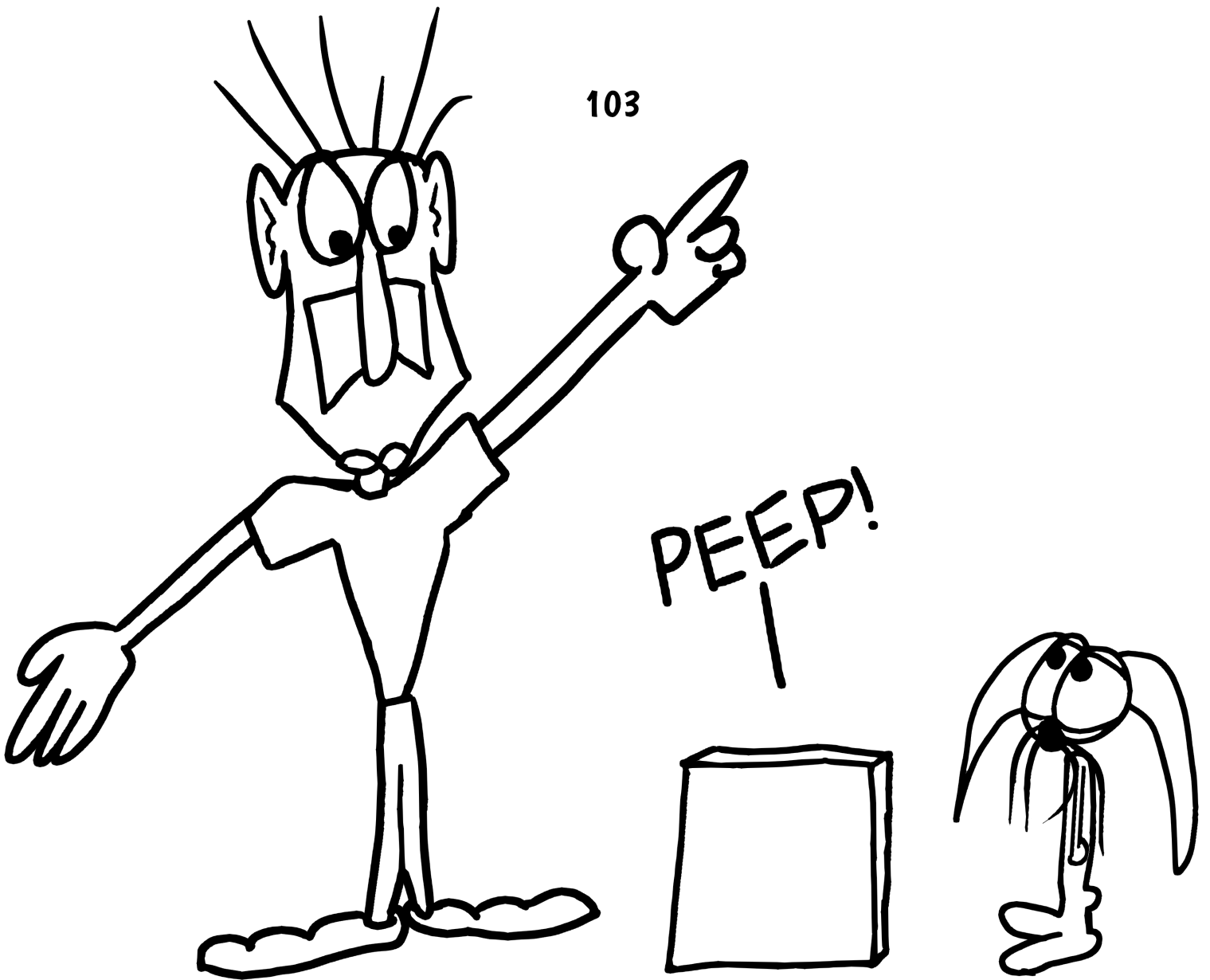
Rat could see that Dan was angry.



PEEP!

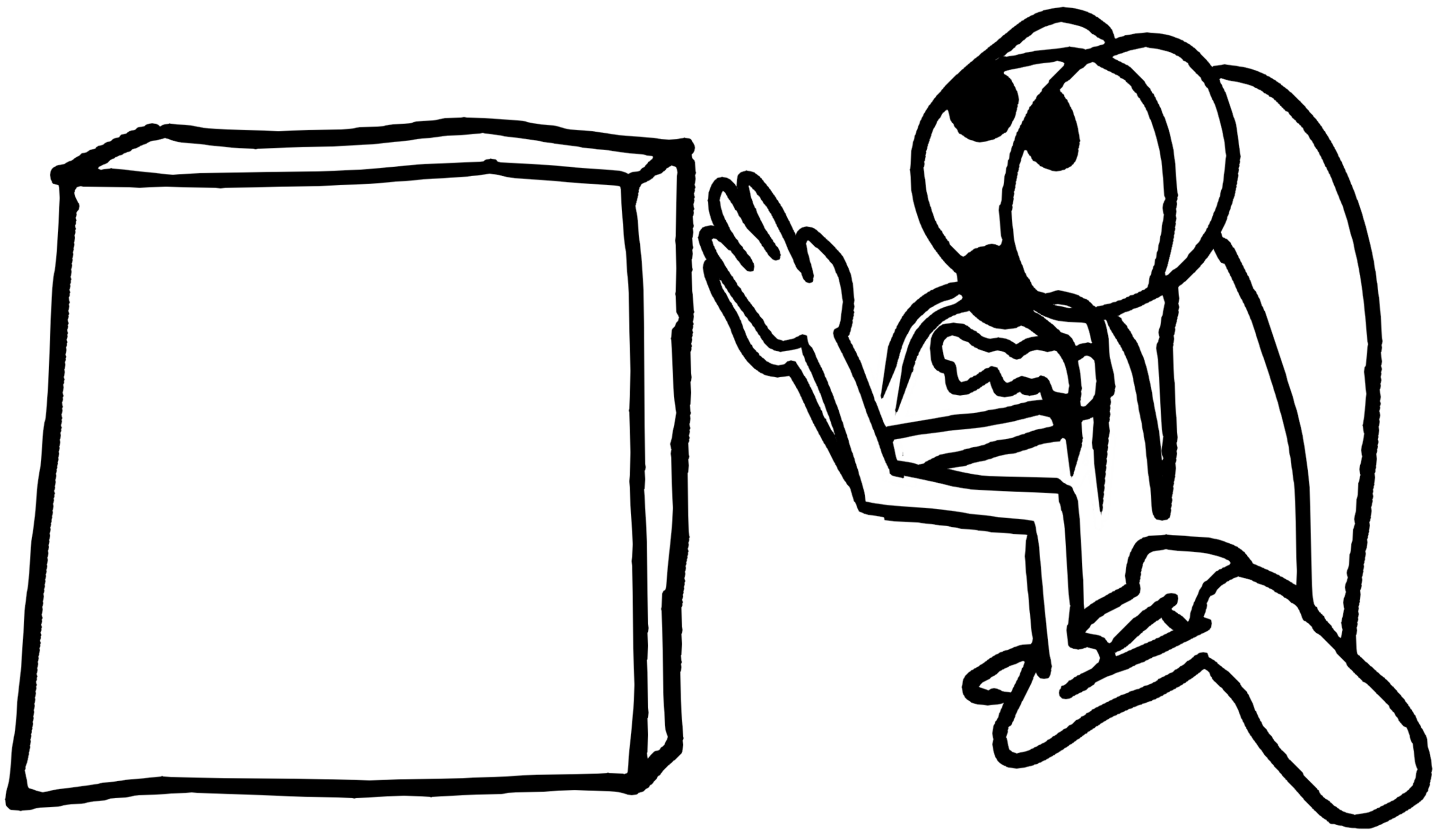


Rat did keep a zoo animal to be his pet. Rat hid it in a red box. "The hen let me," said Rat. "PEEP!" said the chick in the box.

"PEEP!" said the chick.

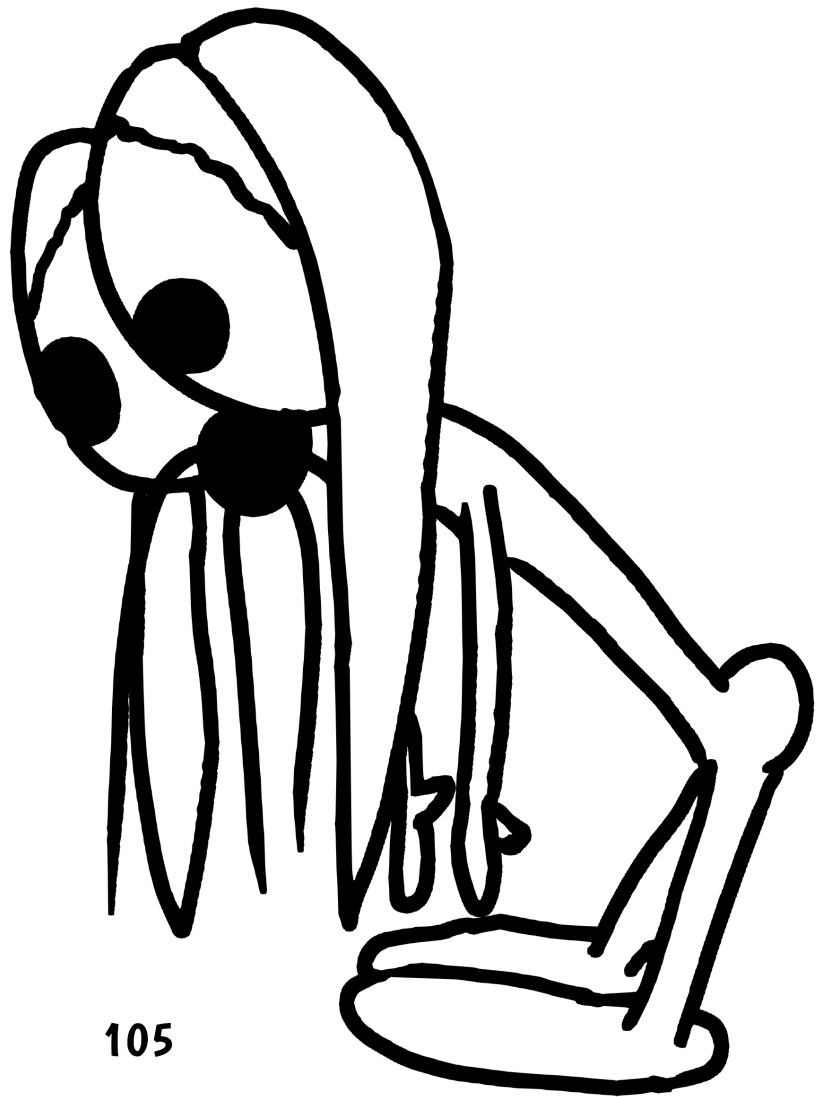


"Oh if you let me keep it I will hug it and feed it seed!" said Rat. "I will take care of it! I will meet its needs!"

"No," said Dan. "You did a bad deed Rat."

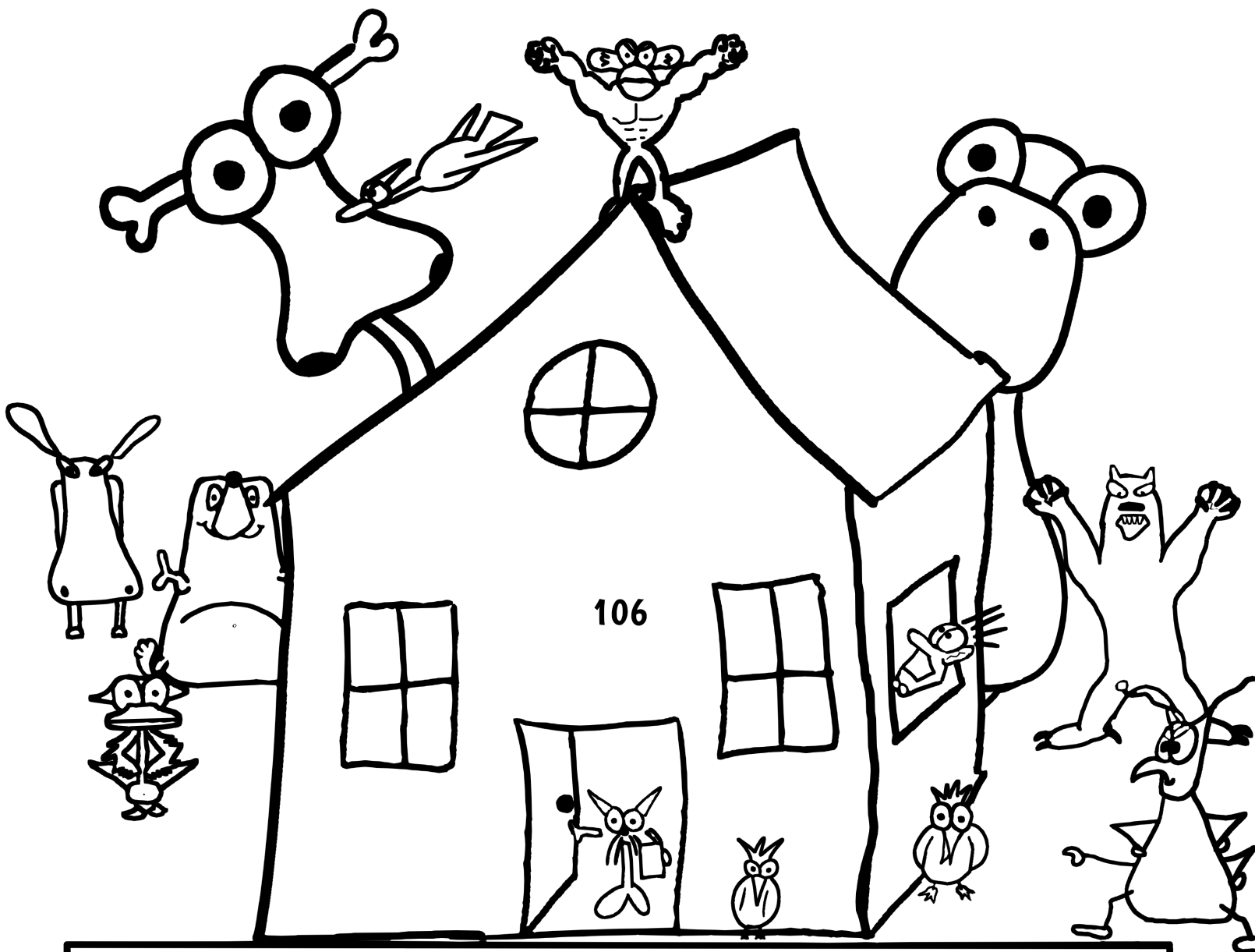
