
Dan and Rat The Cat rode a bike to Pine Lake. At the lake Rat saw a big hole.

"A mole hole Dan!" said Rat. "A big mole hole!"




"If I had a pole I could get the mole," said Rat. So Dan gave Rat a pole.

Rat put the pole into the hole, but Rat could not get the mole.




"If I had a rope I could get the mole," said Rat. So Dan gave Rat a rope, but Rat could not get the mole.

The hole was too big.




"Get into the hole," said Dan.

Rat did go down the rope into the hole.


"I hope Rat can get back up the rope!" said Dan.
