
Dan is a man. Dan has a van.

Sam saw Dan in the van.




Sam saw a cat in the van. The cat was tan, like the van. The cat was not a rat. the cat was a cat. The cat sat on a mat in the van.




Sam said, "I can tap on the van."

But the cat's name was *Rat.*Rat The Cat was angry!




Rat The Cat was so angry!
